Ou Virak

Ou Virak is the President of the CCHR. He is the founder of the Alliance for Freedom of Expression in Cambodia (AFEC) and the winner of the 2007 Reebok Human Rights Award. Virak read Economics at California State University and was Vice-President of the National Cambodian Student Association. He worked in law and public welfare, and then returned to Cambodia to lecture on economics at Pannasastr University, Phnom Penh. He joined the CCHR as Advocacy and Public Relations Director in 2005, and became its President in 2007.



Kalina Khan

Kalina Khan is the CCHR's Director of Finance and Administration. She is an alumna of the University of Technology and Vanda Institute, Phnom Penh; and previously worked as an accountant for a private company, the Cambodian Human Rights Coordination Committee, Human Rights Vigilance, Street Children Assistance & Development Program, and Every Child. She joined the CCHR in November 2007.



Rupert Abbott

Rupert Abbott is the CCHR's Director of Development and Programs. He is an alumnus of the University of Oxford, where he read Modern History and was President of the Oxford University Law Society and his Hall's Student Union. He read Law at the University of Sussex and College of Law, worked as a political researcher, and then joined the global law firm Baker & McKenzie. He is a qualified lawyer and in 2007 he was 'Highly Commended' by the Law Society of England and Wales for his *pro bono* work. He worked for the United Nations Assistance to the Khmer Rouge Trials (UNAKRT) before joining the CCHR at the end of 2008.
