



## **PROFESSIONAL LEGAL VOLUNTEERS**

The Cambodian Center for Human Rights (CCHR) seeks **Professional Legal Volunteers** interested in working in a voluntary capacity for a human rights organization. We ask that Professional Legal Volunteers commit to spending a minimum of six weeks with us. We can accommodate Professional Legal Volunteers at any time of the year.

### **Duties and responsibilities**

Professional Legal Volunteers work under the supervision of the CCHR Management Committee to provide expertise, assistance and leadership on matters including legal research and writing as part of the CCHR's research and policy work, and legal research to support the CCHR's projects.

### **Requirements**

Applicants must have an interest in and passion for human rights. They must have at least three years experience working as a lawyer. Applicants must be able to volunteer for at least six weeks. Successful applicants must be able to bring and use a laptop computer with wireless internet functionality for the duration of their stay.

### **Organization**

The CCHR is a non-political, independent, non-governmental organization that works to promote and protect democracy and respect for human rights throughout Cambodia. We focus primarily on civil and political rights, although we work on a variety of interlinked human rights issues. Members of staff are grouped into four specialist Units that reflect the scope of our work: Freedom of Expression; Fair Trials; Land Rights; and Democracy.
